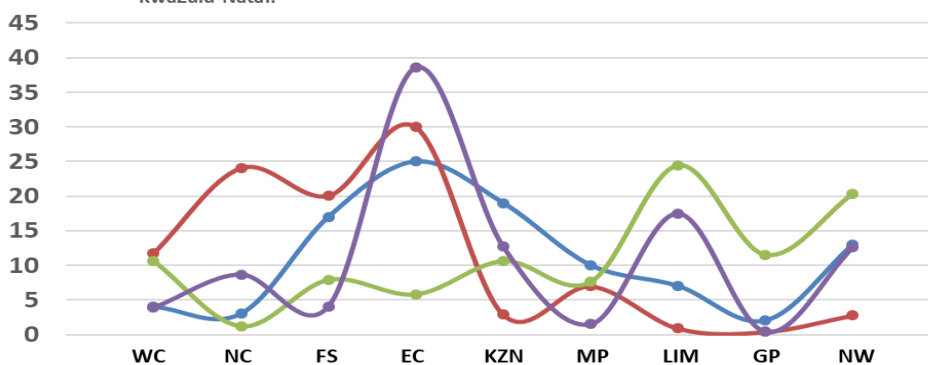

- BEESTE: Die meeste beeste word in die Oos-Kaap aangetref, gevolg deur KwaZulu-Natal en dan die Vrystaat.
- SKAPE: Die hoogste getal skape word in die Oos-Kaap gevind, gevolg deur die Noord-Kaap en dan die Vrystaat.
- VARKE: Die meeste varke word in Limpopo aangetref, gevolg deur Noordwes en dan die Gauteng and Wes-Kaap.
- BOKKE: Oos-Kaap het die meeste aantal bokke, gevolg deur onderskeidelik Limpopo en KwaZulu-Natal.



NOTAS (JUN 2021 – AUG 2021)

Reën:

Normale tot ondernormale reënval is oor die tydperk in die land aangemeld.

Vee:

Gemiddelde toestand word as redelik gerapporteer. FS het sterftes as gevolg van 'n koue tyd aangemeld, terwyl dit weens veldbrande in NW was. Uitbrekings is in verskillende provinsies aangemeld, insluitend FnM in KZN, en Afrika-brucellose, ASF en hondsdolheid in Gauteng.

Weiding / veld:

Gemiddeld was die toestande redelik. Veldbrande is in 'n aantal provinsies aangemeld.

Die Departement waardeur die volgehoue deelname en ondersteuning van dataverskaffers.

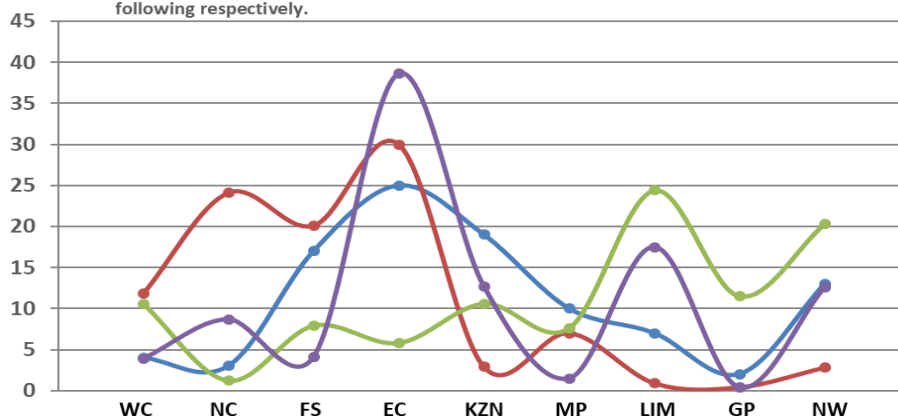

The numbers for cattle, sheep, pigs and goats decreased by approximately 0.52%, 0.65%, 0.88% and 0.39% respectively between August 2020 and August 2021.

Herd Percentage

- CATTLE: Eastern Cape has the highest percentage of cattle, followed by KwaZulu-Natal and Free State.
- SHEEP: The highest percentage of sheep is in Eastern Cape, followed by Northern Cape and Free State.
- PIGS: Pigs are largely in Limpopo, followed by North West, Gauteng and Western Cape.
- GOATS: Eastern Cape has the highest number of goats, with Limpopo and KwaZulu-Natal following respectively.



NOTES (JUN 2021 – AUG 2021)

RAIN:

Normal to below normal rainfall was reported in the country over the period.

LIVESTOCK:

Average condition is reported to be reasonable. FS reported mortalities due to a cold spell, while it was due to veld-fires in NW. Outbreaks were reported in different provinces, including FnM in KZN, and African Brucellosis, ASF and rabies in Gauteng

PASTURE/VELD:

On average, the conditions were reasonable. Veld fires reported in a number of provinces.
