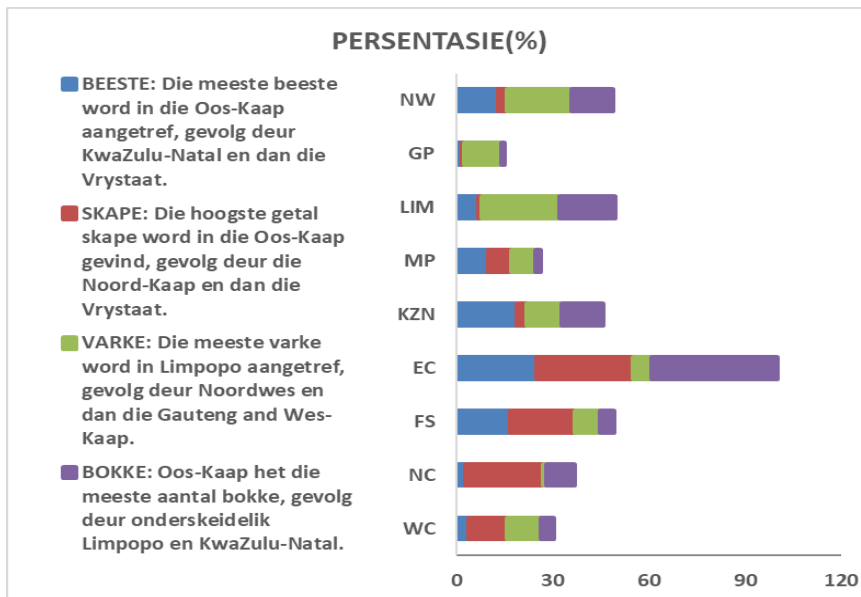

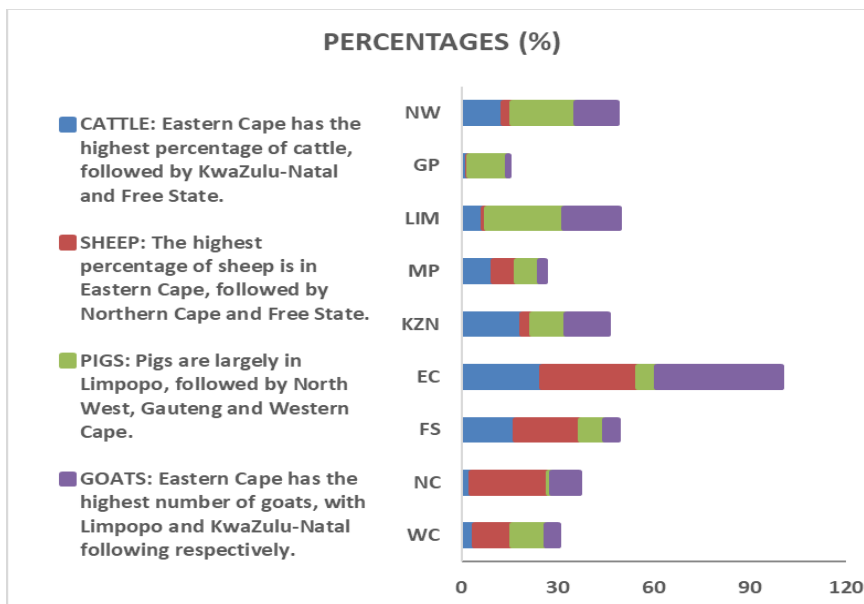

The numbers for cattle, sheep and pigs respectively increased by approximately 0.20%, 0.01% and 0.68%, while for goats decreased by approximately 0.35% between August 2022 and February 2023.



Dec 22 – Feb 23

RAIN:

The average rainfall over the period was normal, with floods and thunderstorm damaging infrastructure in some provinces.

PASTURES/VELD:

Land condition was on average reasonable, with veld fires in NW and KZN.

LIVESTOCK:

Over this period, livestock condition is reasonable on average. GP and LIM recorded F&M outbreaks, while GP recorded African Swine Fever as well.
