Point Raised	Recommendations/suggestions
Crop Grouping	DoH and DAFF should consider setting up a Working Group with all relevant stakeholders in order to advise/revise or update the MRL regulation by expanding the current definitions of various crops using the latest Codex documents. For the latest Codex crop group this link: http://www.fao.org/fao-who-codexalimentarius/codex-texts/dbs/pestres/commodities/en/

DOH – National Institute Of Occupational Health (NIOH)	NIOH to be approached to initiated a study to investigate a Total Diet Study (PHD) and to advise on the IESTI formula currently under discussion at the CCPR. The NIOH is currently working on the budget to accomplish the task that will be shared with stakeholders in order to raise financial resources required to realize the objectives set.
Critical gaps identified by grower groups	The grower groups should engage with registration holders while keeping the office of the registrar informed. Critical gap(s) refers to a situation where there are no registered product(s) to control pests/weeds/diseases or the GAP approved is resulting in a situation that controls the targeted pests/weeds/diseases.
Research concerning agricultural	No product(s) should be used by the growers groups for research
remedies destined for minor crops/use	purposes if intended for registration purposes without consent
registration purposes	from the relevant registration holder(s)
Mushroom grower's list	The meeting with the office of the registrar should occur as soon as possible. This has already happened and the revised priority list is published on the DAFF minor crops website
Protea Industry Research data	The registration holders whose products were used should consider applying for registrations as soon as they are ready to do so.
Dates Industry	The meeting with all stakeholders needs to happen in Upington and the Namibian Registrar should be invited to attend such a meeting.
Edible Flowers	A working group consisting of growers, retailers and other interested parties needs to be established. The Terms of Reference (TOR) will also have to be developed with the aim of developing a global standard for the sector. Collaboration with the EU minor use/crop coordinator may be required.

Fynbos biome	There is a need for SA to consider crafting the Codex standard to

	be adopted as an international standard with the aim of protecting the local industry.
It was noted that there is no vegetable, tomatoes and other minor crops grower associations	 For vegetables, the current seed treatment working group TOR may need to be changed when the working group is done with the task of revising the seed treatment guidelines. The new mandate would be to look at the classification of vegetable crops as well as other nonedible crops ZZ2 should consider helping in organizing tomato growers. Note that this is a major crop. DAFF together with other role players should consider creating a contact list of other minor crops grower groups that did not take part in this workshop. DAFF Directorates Functions and other	A better system of coordination is needed with DAFF and other
sister departments	relevant sister departments so that cross cutting regulatory issues could be handled efficiently.
Minor crops guidelines and definitions	The current 2010 guidelines needs revision or an update concerning regulatory incentives that may be further adopted as suggested at the Montreal Global Minor Use Summit 3. A working group is needed to work on the task. NB: Please send your name if you want to be considered to be part of the working group.
Emergency Registration Protocol	The draft protocol has been developed by both Croplife and DAFF and still undergoing the consultation phase. The latest document will be circulated.
Future meetings	It was recommended that the national minor crops meeting should happen annually and DAFF should be responsible for the organizing such a meeting.
