6.	Description of content: The objective of the notified document PMRL2020-16 is to consult on the listed maximum residue limit (MRL) for pendimethalin that has been proposed by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).		
	MRL (ppm)1Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity0.1Bulb onions (crop subgroup 3-07A, except dry bulb onions)2
