6. Description of content: The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) has drafted the <i>Import Health Standard for Zoo Bovidae, Giraffidae and Tragulidae (Live Animals and Semen)</i> . The standard allows for certain species of Bovids, Giraffids and Tragulids holding a containment approval by the Environmental Protection Authority to be imported from Australia, Canada, Europe, Japan, Singapore, South Africa, United Arab Emirates and United States of America.
