Import of agricultural products into the Republic of South Africa

The Republic of South Africa has once again been awarded an opportunity to host the 2013 CAF Africa Cup of Nations soccer tournament. A total of 32 nations will be battling it out at this prestigious event. Thousands of visitors from participating nations will flock into our country to support their teams for the duration of the event.

The Directorate Food Import and Export Standards of the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF) would like to inform all national teams and their supporters who will be travelling to South Africa of the import requirements for agricultural products. Such products include animals and animal products, plants and plant products, as well as any other potentially contaminated and infectious things. Bringing in of these products require an import permit from relevant directorates within the DAFF. This is in accordance with the Republic's relevant acts and regulations which are aimed at preventing the introduction, spread as well as establishment of pests and diseases of plants and animals from other parts of the world.

Also, the importation of certain alcoholic products with an alcohol content of more than one percent into the Republic for drinking purposes is restricted except on the authority of an import certificate issued by the administering officer.
