The Directorate regulates the manufacturing, distribution, importation, sale, use and advertising of fertilisers, animal feeds, pesticides and stock remedies, as well as the operation of sterilising plants and pest control operators in terms of the Fertilisers, Farm Feeds, Agricultural Remedies and Stock Remedies Act, 1947 (Act No. 36 of 1947).

Principal responsibilities

The Directorate is responsible for:

- Evaluating and registering fertilisers, animal feeds, pesticides and stock remedies for use in South Africa
- Assessing the competency and registration of pest control operators (PCO)
- Assessing the suitability and registration of sterilising plants
- Monitoring compliance with the legislation.
