## Addendum

The following communication, received on 20 August 2018, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Canada</u>.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Abamectin

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for abamectin notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1168 (dated 23 May 2018) was adopted 16 August 2018. The proposed MRLs were established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and are provided directly below:

<u>MRL (ppm)</u><sup>1</sup> <u>Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity</u>

0.1 Leafy greens (crop sub group 4-13A)<sup>2</sup>; leaf petioles vegetables (crop sub group 22B)<sup>3</sup>

0.02 Fruiting vegetables (crop group 8-09)<sup>4</sup>

<sup>1</sup> ppm = parts per million

<sup>2</sup> The MRL of 0.1 ppm is extended from Crop Group 4 to all of Crop Subgroup 4-13A.

<sup>3</sup> The MRL of 0.1 ppm is extended from celery to all of Crop Subgroup 22B, except for cardoon, Chinese celery, and rhubarb which will retain the current MRL of 0.1 ppm.

<sup>4</sup> The MRL of 0.02 ppm is extended from Crop Group 8 to all of Crop Subgroup 8-09.

MRLs are established for each commodity included in the listed crop groupings in accordance with the *Residue Chemistry Crop Groups* webpage (<u>https://www.canada.ca/en/health-canada/services/consumer-product-safety/pesticides-pest-management/public/protecting-your-health-environment/pesticides-food/residue-chemistry-crop-groups.html</u>) in the Pesticides and Pest Management section of Health Canada's website.
