Addendum

The following communication, received on 14 December 2023, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Established Maximum Residue Limit: Difenoconazole

The proposed maximum residue limit (PMRL) document for difenoconazole notified in G/SPS/N/CAN/1530 (dated 19 September 2023) was adopted 13 December 2023. The proposed MRL was established via entry into the Maximum Residue Limits Database and is provided directly below:

MRL (ppm)¹ Raw Agricultural Commodity (RAC) and/or Processed Commodity

8.0 Leaves of root and tuber vegetables (human food or animal feed) (crop group 2, except garden beet tops², radish leaves³ and turnip greens³)

¹ ppm = parts per million

² Garden beet tops are excluded from this MRL action as an MRL of 8.0 ppm is already established for this commodity.

³ Radish leaves and turnip greens are excluded from this MRL action as an MRL of 35 ppm is already established for these commodities.
