**6. Description of content:** In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2017/625, certain categories of animals and goods from third countries should always be presented at a border control post for official controls to be performed prior to their entry into the Union.

This Implementing Regulation establishes the lists of the different animals and products of animal origin, germinal products, animal by-products and derived products, hay and straw and composite products to be presented for official controls at border control posts with the indication of their respective Combined Nomenclature (CN) code provided for in Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87.

As new conditions for the entry into the Union of composite products will apply from 21 April 2021 in accordance with Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/625, the current rules on composite products in Decision 2007/275/EC should continue to apply until then. Hence, this Regulation does not apply to composite products.
