Description of content:</b> It follows from Regulation (EU) 2017/625 on official controls and other official activities performed to ensure the application of requirements of food, feed and plant health that certain consignments of food and feed of non-animal origin, plants, plant products and other objects should be subject to official controls at the border control posts. In certain cases identity checks and physical checks of these consignments may be performed at designated control points other than border control posts.<br><br>This Delegated Regulation lays down specific rules for identity checks and physical checks performed at designated control points on consignments of plants, plant products, and other objects referred to in Article 47(1)(c) and (e) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625 and food and feed of non-animal origin subject to the measures provided for by the acts referred to in Article 47(1)(d)(e) and (f) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625. This Delegated Regulation also stipulates requirements for documentary checks performed at distance from the border control post on consignments of plants, plant products, and other objects referred to in Article 47(1)(c) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625. |
