Description of content: This draft Commission Implementing Regulation provides that the approval of the active substance alpha-cypermethrin is withdrawn in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009. EU member States shall withdraw authorisations for plant protection products containing alpha-cypermethrin as an active substance.

This decision only concerns the placing on the market of this substance and plant protection products containing it. Following withdrawal and the expiry of all grace periods for stocks of products containing this substance, separate action will likely be taken on MRLs and a separate notification will be made in accordance with SPS procedures.

This draft Commission Implementing Regulation was also notified under the TBT Agreement in notice G/TBT/N/EU/770.
