## NOTIFICATION

Corrigendum

The following communication, received on 6 February 2024, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the <u>European Union</u>.

<u>Temporary increase of official controls and emergency measures governing the entry into the Union</u> of certain goods from certain third countries

The following technical mistakes were highlighted in Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/286 notified in G/SPS/N/EU/712 (18 January 2024):

- Several lines between the commodities were missing or wrongly inserted and created confusion in relation to groups of commodities for particular hazards and to which commodities belonged to which country of origin;
- The footnote for okra from India due to possible contamination by pesticide residues was wrongly indicated.

These technical mistakes were corrected by Corrigenda 2024/90066 and 2024/90035 to Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/286 of 16 January 2024 amending Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1793 on the temporary increase of official controls and emergency measures governing the entry into the Union of certain goods from certain third countries implementing Regulations (EU) 2017/625 and (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
