Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: This MO was issued based on the official report submitted by Dr Nadav Galon, Director, Veterinary Services and Animal Health, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, Bet Dagan, Israel to the World Health Organization for Animal Health (OIE) on 23 January 2017, confirming that there were nine outbreaks of H5N8 Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus in five provinces. It affects farms for turkeys, heavy breeders and layers.
