 - Aldicarb;
 - Aldrin;
 - Azinphos-ethyl;
 - Binapacryl;
 - Camphechlor (CLC);
 - Captafol;
 - Chlordimeform;
 - Chlorobenzilate;
 - Dibromochloropropane;
 - Dinitro-ortho-cresol (DNOC);
 - Dinoseb;
 - Endrin;
 - Heptachlor;
 - Hexachlorobenzene;
 - Kepone;
 - Phosphamidon;
 - Phosphorus containing formulations;
 - Propham.
