VII. A cooperative which is at least 51% owned by black people;

VIII. An EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people who are military veterans

The 80/20 Preference Point system will be applied where a maximum of Eighty (80) tender adjudication points will be awarded for price and Twenty (20) points will be awarded for preference.
