**SUBMISSION OF PLANT MATERIAL FOR DISTINCTNESS, UNIFORMITY & STABILITY (DUS)  
EVALUATIONS**

This serves to inform you that the following is required for the DUS testing of ornamental species in South Africa:

- 10 plants of flowering size. The exceptions are, for:
  - Bulbs: 15-20 bulbs of flowering size
  - Roses: 5 plants of flowering size (if they are bare rooted- 10 plants)
  - Protea, Leucadendron, Leucospermum and Geraldton Wax: 5 plants of flowering size
- The plants should all be of the same age, be planted in the same soil and submitted to the same environmental conditions. Should the variety be grafted on to a rootstock, the rootstock should be the same for all plants.
