

4.59 million kg's


















MOHAIR PROCESSING

APPROX 80% PROCESSED IN SA




MOHAIR EXPORTS – APPROX 70% EXPORTED IN PROCESSED FORM





MOHAIR DEMAND > SUPPLY



- Support and assistance to upcoming farmers
- Promote BEE





Current Developments & Progress

- The Trust is currently running 8 development projects involving a total of ± 6000 goats
- 4 projects settled in total & 2 New projects identified for 2022
- The MET farmers contributes about ± 16 000kg of mohair per year
- 100 % of MET farmers are Responsible Mohair Standard certified
- Farmworkers Training
- Strengthening relationship with Government
- Empowering female farmers








