

THAILAND INTERNATIONAL COOPERARTION AGENCY (TICA) ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE (AITC) 2023



The Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development (DALRRD) received an invitation to participate in the Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TICA) short training programmes for 2023. The main aim of the TICA programmes is to share Thailand's best practices and experience with the world. The Annual International Training Courses (AITC) focus on development topics. These are categorised under five themes, namely Food Security, Climate Change, Public Health, other topics relating to Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and "Sufficiency Economy Philosophy" or SEP. The SEP aspects were added with an aim to offer an insight into TICA's home-grown development approach, which is the key factor that keeps Thailand on a steady growth path towards sustainable development in many areas.

- Should be working in a field relating to the training topic;
- Should have a degree and/or professional experience suitable to the training topic;
- English proficient;
- Less than 55 years of age;
