## SCHEDULE

### Definition

1. In this Schedule “the Control Measures” means the control measures published in Government Notice No. R. 110 of 27 January 1984, as amended by Government Notices Nos. ### **Amendment of definitions of the Control Measures**

2. The definitions of the Control Measures are hereby amended by the insertion of the following definitions-

**“demarcated quarantine area”** means an area determined by order under Section 7 of the Act or specified in terms of the control measures within which a quarantine pest is present and is being officially controlled;

**“Inspection”** means an official visual examination of plants, plant products or other regulated articles to determine if pests are present or to determine compliance with phytosanitary regulations;

**“quarantine pest”** means any pest of potential economic importance to the area endangered thereby and not yet present there, or present but not yet widely distributed and being officially controlled;

**“regulated pest”** means a quarantine pest or a regulated non-quarantine pest;

**“visual examination”** means the physical examination of plant products, or other regulated articles using the unaided eye, lens, stereoscope or microscope to detect pests or contaminants without testing or processing;

### **Substitution of definition of the Control Measures**

3. The definition **“nursery”** of the control measures is hereby substituted by the following-

**“nursery”** means a business where plants or propagating material is propagated and grown for sale, and which is registered in terms of the Plant Improvement Act, 2018 (Act No. 11 of 2018);

**Deletion of definition of the Control Measures**

4. The definition “visually free” of the control measures is hereby deleted.

**Amendment of control measure 2 of the Control Measures**

5. Control measure 2 of the Control Measures is hereby substituted by the following control measure-

**“Prohibition relating to the occurrence and removal of certain regulated pests**

- 2 (1) No user of land who is the owner or occupier of a nursery shall-
- (a) keep any regulated pests specified in Table 1 on the premises of such nursery;
  - (b) keep, plant or cultivate any plant on the premises of such nursery unless such plant is-
    - i. visual examined of the regulated pests specified in Table 1; and
    - ii. tested free from the regulated pests specified Table 1.
  - (c) keep any infectious thing on the premises of such nursery unless such infectious thing is free from the regulated pests specified in Table 1.
- (2) No user of land shall remove any plant from any land within the Republic to any other land within the Republic unless such plant is-
- (a) visually examined, tested free and or found to be free from the regulated pests specified in Table 1.
- (3) No user of land shall remove any infectious thing from any land within the Republic to any other land within the Republic unless such infectious thing is free from the regulated pests specified in Table 1.

- (4) No user of land shall remove any plant or plant product that are-
- (a) infested or infected by the regulated pests specified in Table 1 from any land where regulated pests specified in Table 1 occurs;
  - (b) suspected to be infested or infected by the regulated pests specified in Table 1 from any land where the regulated pests specified in Table 1 occur or suspected to occur;
  - (c) from any area within the Republic demarcated or quarantined by the authority where the regulated pests specified in Table 1 occur, unless the movement is authorised by means of a permit by the authority to certify free from the regulated pests specified in Table 1;
  - (d) from any demarcated quarantine area within the Republic without authorization.”

**Amendment of control measure 3 of the Control Measures**

6. The control measure 3 of the Control Measures is hereby amended by the following expression-

The heading of the control measure 3 is substituted by the following-

**“Prohibition relating to keeping, planting or cultivation of certain plants”**

Sub-control measure 3 (4) is substituted by the following expression-

“3 (4) No user of land shall remove, keep, plant or cultivate any plant of a kind specified in column 1 of Table 7 originating from any land within an area specified in column 2 of the said Table on any land within an area indicated in column 3 of the said Table.”

**Amendment of sub-control measure 4 (3) of the Control Measures**

7. The sub-control measure 4 (3) of the Control Measures is hereby deleted.

**Amendment of control measure 4 A of the Control Measures**

8. The sub-control measure 4A (1) and (2) of the Control Measures is hereby deleted.
