AGRICULTURAL PESTS ACT, 1983 (ACT No. 36 OF 1983)

**REGULATIONS: AMENDMENT\***

#### SCHEDULE

#### Definition

In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the regulations published by Government Notice No. R. 111 of 27 January 1984, as amended by Government Notices Nos.
