Guidelines for Presidential Employment Stimulus (PESI) Beneficiaries

DOs for PESI beneficiaries

- 1. The Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development (DALRRD) communicates with PESI beneficiaries by means of SMS. Therefore, please respond to SMS sent only by DALRRD.
- 2. Save all SMSes sent by DALRRD on your cell phone. If possible, please write them down for future use or in case you lose your cell phone.
- 3. When in doubt about anything regarding PESI, please do the following:
 - a. Call your provincial PESI coordinator on the number at the bottom of these guidelines.
 - b. Send a SMS including the name of your province.
 - c. Send an email to queries@dalrrd.gov.za and in the message, include the name of your province and the cell phone number that you used to apply for PESI.
 - d. Visit or call your local office of the Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development.
 - e. Visit or call the office of your local extension officer.
- 4. If you have lost your cell phone and you cannot do a sim swap, always contact any of the government officials for assistance, using any of the communication methods above.
- 5. For any other enquiry regarding PESI, please use the above-mentioned information to communicate with the department.
- 6. Request full identification from the caller (their location, institution and names) and keep the records.

The DON'Ts for PESI beneficiaries

- Do not respond to messages from social media platforms, e.g. Facebook, Twitter, WhatsApp, emails, YouTube, etc.
- 2. Do not act on any instruction that you are given by unknown people, always ask the caller to identify themselves.
- 3. Do not give personal information (like ID numbers) to anyone.
- 4. Do not exchange voucher into cash. Should you be found doing that, legal steps will be taken against you and you will be blacklisted from government support for five years.
- 5. Do not deviate from the agricultural project that you have applied in line with the DALRRD commodities.
- 6. Do not give your voucher number to people pretending to be suppliers (scammers) on social media. The department will guide you regarding where to redeem the voucher.
