- If shortlisted, you will be required to avail yourself, your related farming machinery and equipment and your
 livestock (biological assets) where applicable for verification purposes and attend Evaluation interviews at the
 time and place determined by the Department during which, you will be expected to present a Business
 plan/proposal based on the information gathered during the compulsory farm visit.
