- c. Letter of no objection or approval from the Department responsible for environmental affairs in the Province
- d. Written Hygiene Management System.
- e. Agreement with a meat inspection service provider for the rendering of a meat inspection service.
- f. A schedule of the proposed period during which the slaughter will take place at the specified slaughter site(s).

The abattoir shall, apart from the Meat Safety Act (Act 40 of 2000), have to comply with the regulations of the local authority and all other relevant authorities.
