SUBJECT: SADC HARMONIZED SOP FOR AI HA/HI (VERSION

2.0) AND THE USE OF 2 ANTIGENS

Some queries were received with regard to the use of 2 antigens.

This memo serves to clarify the correct interpretation of the relevant sections of the abovementioned SOP: Section 7 (7.1) bullet one and Section 11.

- 1. The use of 2 antigens shall mean:
  - a.  $H5N_a$  and  $H5N_b$  /  $H7N_a$  and  $H7N_b$  at the same time (i.e. a total of 4 antigens if testing sera for antibodies against both H5 and H7), or
  - b. 1 antigen (H5N<sub>a</sub> / H7N<sub>a</sub>) with subsequent testing (**compulsory**) of sera found positive on H5 / H7 with a <u>second</u> antigen H5N<sub>b</sub> / H7N<sub>b</sub>
- 2. The SOP has not been amended
